- *Each member must commit to donating \$100 per meeting (\$400 per year). Meetings will be held in January, April, July and October.*
- *The donations will be given to Benzie County 501(c)3 non-profit organizations ONLY; with 100% of the money given to that organization.*
- *No national charities will be considered. The purpose is for 100% of our contributions to stay in our community.*
- *Any member wishing to request donations for a local 501(c)3 non-profit will place her name in a hat upon arrival at the meeting.*
- *Three names will be drawn from the hat.*
- *Each of the three names drawn from the hat will be given 5 minutes to present information on the 501(c)3 non-profit she is promoting. There will be a 5 minute opportunity for members to ask questions.*
- *By ballot, the group will vote, with the understanding that the majority rules. Each member agrees to donate to the chosen cause regardless of her personal views.*
- *If a member's name is drawn and her non profit is not chosen, she will still be eligible to put her name in the drawing at the next meeting.*
- *Lobbying for a favorite organization prior to the meeting is not allowed.*
- *The non-profit will have to agree to **NOT** use the names of members for future solicitations or give the personal information out to the public. If the charity does not adhere to this condition, they will be removed from any future consideration.*
- *The meetings will be held at the Mills Community House on the upper level. Membership in 100 (or more) Women Who Care is open to **ALL** women.*
- *The more women we gather, the greater our impact within our community.*
